# Minutes of last meeting

# Chair's report

Chris Bevans- Vice-Chair on behalf of chair, there have been no events or fundraising since the last meeting due to Covid restrictions. The Vice Chair thanked everyone for what they had done this year.

# Treasurer's report

Nick Farrar- Treasurer gave his report.

Actions around mandates from the last meeting have not been actioned, will action once elected new committee.

The Treasurer explained that this had been a low input year due to Covid, income included;

- Sale of Christmas cards
- Bags to school collections
- Online shopping through Amazon and Smile.

The PTFA had made some donations to the school during the year

The Treasurer explained that any monies held must cover yearly outgoings such as ParentKind membership and Lottery registration. The committee had previously agreed that £1,000 should be held in reserve for commitments that it makes to the school each year such as DARE and leavers books.

Just under this amount is presently held in the account, any request from the school must be met by new fundraising activities.

Questions in response to the treasures report were asked-

- Did the PTFA consider remote fundraising during lockdown? This did not happen
