



## Admission appeals for MITRE schools

For applications made for the Academic Year 2022-23

If an application for a school place is refused there is the right to appeal that decision. All appeals will be heard by an independent panel and will be clerked independently

Appellants have 20 school days from the date of notification that their application was unsuccessful to prepare and lodge their written appeal. An appeal form should be obtained from the school, completed and returned to the school to lodge an appeal.

Each appellant has the right to 10 school days' notice of an appeal hearing, although this can be waived with the agreement of all parties.

For applications made in the normal admissions round, appeals will be heard within 40 school days of the deadline for lodging appeals. For in-year applications, appeals will be heard within 30 school days of the appeal being lodged.

For MITRE schools the following timetable will be adhered to for the normal admissions round 2022-23.

### Appeals for Year 7 entry (secondary transfer)

| Process                                    | Date   |

| National offer day                         | Monday 1 March 2022                                |
| Appeals deadline (20 school days)          | Tuesday 29 March 2022                              |
| Appeals to be heard by (40 school days)    | Wednesday 15 June 2022                             |
| Appeals lodged after Tuesday 29 March 2022 | 40 school days from the date the appeal was lodged |

### Appeals for foundation 2 entry (first time admissions 4+)

| Process                                 | Date   |

| National offer day                      | Monday 18 April 2022                               |
| Appeals deadline (20 school days)       | Monday 23 May 2022                                 |
| Appeals to be heard by (40 school days) | Tuesday 13 September 2022                          |
| Appeals lodged after Monday 23 May 2022 | 40 school days from the date the appeal was lodged |

Once an appeal has been lodged with the school the information provided will be sent to the independent clerk who will then proceed with the arrangements for the hearing. The information provided will also be shared with the school and the independent panel.
