PE Days

This term Oak Class will do PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays, Maple Class will do PE on Thursdays and go swimming on Fridays and Cherry Class will do PE on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

On PE days children need to come to school in their PE kit. Please make sure that all jewellery is removed or taped up, and long hair is tied back – thank you.



Class Arrangements for this Year

This year the children are once again in three classes, which are arranged as follows:

Miss Wilmott will work alongside Mrs Lo Bue in Cherry Class, and Mrs Sissons will work in Maple and Oak Classes and also cover the teachers' PPA sessions on Thursdays.

On Tuesday and Wednesday afternoons Mrs Fraser will continue to release Mrs Francis for her Leadership Time.



Water Bottles

Please can the children bring a water bottle to school every day, this should be filled with water (not squash or juice). Please make sure that the bottle they bring is one that they can open easily themselves, and is clearly labelled with their name, thank you.



Pupil Premium Grant

Children of parents and carers who are in receipt of certain benefits may be entitled to the Pupil Premium Grant. This grant entitles children to extra support in school, free milk, and reduced cost school visits and after school clubs. If you think you may be entitled to this grant, please contact the School Office and we can give you more information.

Children whose parents work in His Majesty's Armed Forces, children who are 'Looked After', and children who are recently adopted, are also entitled to this grant, so if you think your child should receive this funding please notify the School Office as soon as possible, thank you.



Nuts in school

Please can parents and carers be aware that we have several children in school who are allergic to nuts. We therefore ask that children do not bring any nuts, or foods containing nuts, in their packed lunches or snack, thank you.



School Times

The children will be collected from the playground at **8.50am** each morning by their teachers.

Please do not leave your child unsupervised on the playground before 8.40am as there is no staff member on duty before then, thank you. If your child arrives after 8.50am for any reason, please bring them in through Reception. School finishes at **3.25pm**.



School Meals

The Autumn Term menu is now available on the IFG website so that Parents and Carers can order their children's school meals. Please remember to order by midnight on Saturday for the following week's meals.

Cool Milk

The children in Cherry Class are eligible for the milk in schools scheme. If your child would like milk in school this needs to be ordered online at www.coolmilk.com

Milk is free until your child is 5 years old, and for children in receipt of the Pupil Premium Grant, there is a small charge for other infant aged children. Please order your child's milk online even if they are entitled to free milk as they only send us enough milk to cover the online orders.



Form for Leave of Absence During Term Time

There are national regulations for Pupil Attendance, which includes term time holidays. The school's policy can be seen on our website www.halamprimary.org.uk in the "Key Information" section under "Policies and Documents".

These regulations make it very clear that absence during term time will only be granted in exceptional circumstances, and that unauthorised absences of ten sessions or more in a rolling period of ten school weeks may lead to a penalty notice (fine) being issued.

Please note that the **threshold for penalty notices is ten sessions**, (not "more than ten sessions"), which means that if your child misses ten sessions (five days) of school then a penalty notice will be issued.

If you do need to take your child out of school during term time please complete the Holiday Request Form which is also available on our school website in "School Office" under "Useful Forms and School Meals".
